Overcoming in 2012

Revelation 2 & 3

As all of us contemplate the coming year, it is good to remember the warning of Our Lord in Revelation. In His warning to all the seven churches, Jesus tells them to **overcome**. He says that the love of some will grow cold, they will be challenged with heresies and Satan will try to destroy them. But Jesus also gives strong reasons to keep the faith and just put your hand to the plow and not look back. We are in dangerous time. Even now the mystery of iniquity is working. But Jesus has overcome the devil and his promises for Overcomers are awesome. He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches:

To him who overcomes, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God. He who overcomes will not be hurt at all by the second death.

To him who overcomes, I will give some of the hidden manna. I will also give him a white stone with a new name written on it, known only to him who receives it.

To him who overcomes and does my will to the end, I will give authority over the nations— 'He will rule them with an iron scepter; he will dash them to pieces like pottery— just as I have received authority from my Father. I will also give him the morning star.

He who overcomes will, like them, be dressed in white. I will never blot out his name from the book of life, but will acknowledge his name before my Father and his angels.

Him who overcomes I will make a pillar in the temple of my God. Never again will he leave it. I will write on him the name of my God and the name of the city of my God, the new Jerusalem, which is coming down out of heaven from my God; and I will also write on him my new name.

Released in November 2001. Found a part time job Feb 2002 which turned into a 5 year job as a warehouse manager:) A bit later in 2002 started seeing a young lady and we got married in 2005. We have a son who is 6 and are expecting another child now. After the warehouse job was a Delivery Driver and shipping clerk for a cabinet

company. We moved to Oregon as my wife Jessica got a job promotion and we transferred. Been mostly a stayat-home Dad as my son has ADHD and Autism. Been going to church regularly here. Held a couple of part time jobs in a furniture store and local newspaper. Life has been really good and a blessing as I started to study to become a bible teacher in my church I am attending now.

"Little Lambs School of the Bible gave me inspiration and a real desire to learn God's Word and help me in times of darkness. Since my release from Prison in late 2001, I have become a positive member in society and a true believer that when one has Christ in their life anything is possible. I want to say 'thank you' to the Salas for providing their Bible correspondence course to those in need that could use the support and gain great knowledge that could save their life and most importantly their Souls. Since I completed their course, which gave me a good foundation and a good habit of study, I have gone on to earn my Associate in Religious Education, and a Bachelors in Theology and many other Bible based certificates and diplomas. Dear Partners,

We want to thank you all for your support in 2011. Together we have achieved so much. And the work and testing continue into the New Year. For the Correspondence School of the Bible, we will renew our efforts to make direct contact with the Chaplains in more prisons this year. They are a good source of referrals to inmates within the institutions. As the postage goes up, we always see a drop in inmate participation as postage is a huge problem with some. The prisons stopped subsidize inmate lessons many years ago so we do provide return postage so that indigent inmates can study The Word of God with us. As usual, the budgets were cut and services in the prisons continue to suffer. But we are encouraged by the letters we receive and the gratitude that is expressed for the new life they have found. And we so enjoy sending those Graduation Bibles into the prisons. We receive little reward here on earth, but I can't wait to see the fruit when we get to heaven!!

Our postage will be going up January 22, about a penny an ounce. Most of our mail is 3 to 5 ounces so we are expecting a few cents a package. Last year we mailed approximately 7,000 to 7,500 packages to prison, excluding bibles.

As for Grace Place, you have made a little heaven here on earth! We have been 75 days up and running. We tell each other that it is our learning curve and learning we are. But God is faithful to give us what we need and to give us his wisdom. We need more!! We have several volunteer teachers who give us Bible lessons, Kitchen and Garden skills, and group meetings. Ms. Kim Tish is growing as housemother and so many in the community helped to make this an wonderful Christmas. Our newest addition, a large handmade quilt hanging in our living room (12 ft ceilings) by the Priscilla Height from the Highlands Quilt Guild.
