Evangeline reformatted and retyped all our Spanish studies in the Little Lambs School of the Bible. The volunteer hours invested by these ladies unselfishly is mind boggling. God has given us the best in devoted staff who give and give.

In April we began rebuilding 543 Magnolia Ave the Grace Place for Women. This was a complete renovation. Every inch of the inside is new, including plumbing and electric.

Our first Banquet and Silent Auction ever was an attempt to raise funds, however in this economy we did a little more than break even, however we became rich in new friends and in raising the awareness about our availability.

Helen came our way and went into the community telling many about Grace Place and our service to others and businesses in the community gave needed materials for Grace Place Woman's Home. John & Eileen's and many friends worked tirelessly on this Women's Home.

Now, can I tell you why I am so grateful? He supplies strength for the weak. He rewards the diligent. He guards and He guides. The good news is nothing can stop Him from pouring out His blessing. He's enduringly strong and entirely faithful. Do you know Him? If you do, please help us. We have GREAT NEEDS FOR 2011. The School of the Bible needs you. Everything we do needs you. To open Grace Place for Women to overcome habits, failure, cursed thinking and the world, we have to complete outside. Men are interested in helping us, but we will need: 3 loads of dirt, grading, irrigation pipes and connectors, renting equipment to accomplish the above, sod (\$1600 worth), and 196 feet of 6 foot fence to keep the ladies safe. We are a 6 to 12 month intensive residential program.

In our little corner of the world there has been devastating times for many. Businesses have suffered great loss yet I've heard them say things like "We don't have any money but we have inventory" and donated thousands in materials to Grace Place. A business down to 1 crew from 5 said to me "I have to be a part of this" and provided materials & labor. These men and women trust the word of God which tells us; (Amplified Version) Gal 6:9 "Let us not lose heart and grow weary and faint in acting nobly and doing right, for in due time and at the appointed season we shall reap, if we do not loosen and relax our courage and faint." We can never give up or give in. We are an army bound together by a covenant sealed in blood and a sacrificial love that was nailed to death for us. He's no longer the baby Jesus, but a risen, resurrected Savior. Now with Abba Father ever living to make intercession of us. We Win Family!!
