Dear Friends,

I find myself wanting to reach out to ya'll and to say how blessed I am to have found the Sala Bible Study (Lil Lamb). I truly enjoy the study, mostly I like how it goes from Old to New Testament. I am learning where to go in my bible just by opening it to the chapter I need. Before I

had to refer to the contents in the front of my bible. I look forward to all the rewards the rest of your study is going to avail me. I am currently doing a <u>double life sentence without parole</u>. The strange thing is, I'm ok with that (we reap what we sow) once I've come to realize it was not the fault of my God, but the choices I made to lead a life a crime. As far back as I can remember I have always blamed God for all my misfortunes. I have cussed out the Lord and asked Him, Why?! Years later as I sat in my cell, convicted of the R.I.C.O. act, after the drugs and booze was out of my system it all became clear to me! God had never condemned me, in fact had it not been for me being a chosen one by God, I'd be dead. I now realized my hate and anger was towards the wrong direction. God loves me so much it doesn't matter how sinful I was. This realization was too much for me to face alone, so I finally got down on my knees and asked God to take over my life. I also know to expect any and everything in God's own time. Well, my friends, I love ya'll for all you do for men and woman like myself. We look forward to doing all studies you provide. Brother Norm Metzger went to be with the Lord in January. A retired school principal in Pennsylvania, he first volunteered to help tutor for a GED program. With the opening of the Teacherage we did not continue that program but he became a grader for Little Lambs. He took some years off with the death of his beloved wife and his own illness but came back last year. He was very diligent. Brother Norm could encourage students like no other. Honest, sincere and interested in their work, his comments made all of us who read them feel so inspired. He worked fast, often bringing in lessons twice a week. But alas, we did not know that his disease was progressing. Even in December he was still grading lessons. Shortly thereafter he went home to Pennsylvania and surrendered his life to the Lord.

I personally want to thank you for a very good year. We have continued the work that the Lord has called us too and you have made it all possible. After getting all the legal (taxes) things out of the way, we are now focusing on painting the Ministry building. The last time work was done on the exterior was around 2006, after the hurricanes. That means we have some extensive repairs then lots of scraping and painting. Bill Daily, builder and contractor, has volunteered to help with the repairs and Gregg Carr of MC Painting has volunteered to supervise and help with the painting and scraping. We are asking for paint donations and you can pray about that. The men at Hogar Resa will be helping us with the



scraping and painting also. We will also remove the awnings and hopefully install new ones. Our old ones were rotten to the core! The repair and replacement of some rotten wood is also being done by our friend Albert Merriweather. Please keep us in your prayers, especially our volunteers, some of which have serious health challenges. They are such a loyal bunch! Wednesday I visited the new Hogar RESA facility in Wauchula. Filling both the Avon Park home and the Sebring Grace home, Hogar expanded to Wauchula last fall. They have leased a former doctor's office with lots of exam rooms that are perfect dorm rooms. With six in all, their capacity is 12 to 16 men and are now full. From here they will have their own spiritual programs and participate in treatment and work with the Avon Park Hogar. Supervisor of the home is Juan Ortiz. Juan and Carmelo, the founder, attended treatment together as young men around the age of 18 in Puerto Rico and recently reconnected.

They still have some work to be done, like secure fencing and porch. They will be a welcome asset to the community as there are numerous Hispanic churches and families in that area. The general population is probably 50% Hispanic in Hardee County. Continue to pray for them as they sell their products to earn their upkeep. We tried all their pies at Christmas
