I was convicted for murdering my husband. I was trying to kill myself, he was trying to take the gun away from me and was accidently shot. I still shot myself in the left chest, but God let me live. The Drs. Called it miraculous. But the family wanted revenge. I was so depressed and had 2 other attempts, so I know good will come out of my stay in prison. I got life and it is so hard at times. Being away from my family who live in Atlanta, Ga. But I know God has a plan and I just try to do the best I can in here. Sometimes it seems unbearable, the shame of what people think of me. How this month has quickly sped away! First we had a splendid day with most of our volunteers over for lunch and a time of fellowship. Then it is was quickly off on a babysitting trip in Orlando as my son and his wife competed in a Fred Astaire competition. I had a week with Little Alex. Then for Thanksgiving I was able to spend a few days with Natalie and her little Emmett. However during this past month, Jan's sister, Louella passed away after a long illness. Louella had volunteered for us for a short time years ago. Jan is in Ohio to celebrate Louella's life with her family. Now that we are back it is business as

usual with over 70 studies coming in on Monday!!! No lack of work here. Praise the Lord.

We have started our Christmas rush with cards placed in all our bible studies as well as the gifts and treats to our small groups. Tanglewood Community Church's Diane Lowery has organized the women there to make packages of cookies and tracts and books for all the students. Especially touching are the books and CD's for children with bible stories and songs. We have made them

available to our classes at the prison. They can write us to send them to their families. These go over very well with the parents as do the 'comic book bibles'. Through Tanglewood, we make bibles, books and now CD's available to each and every person coming to the Anger Management/Parenting Class. As you probably

know, Diane is a Tuesday volunteer and a grader. Actually our favorite type of volunteer, a retired teacher!! They seem to take to the details of grading very well.

As I stated on the cover, we will be losing several of our long-time volunteers. These men and women have dedicated years to our mission. Of course we will need to replace them. Volunteers work from 9 to 12 in the morning unless involved in night meetings or classes. The Hispanic volunteer will need to have some computer literacy to keep the Spanish school in order. This is usually done on Thursday mornings. Our Monday morning and our Thursday seems to need someone in those slots. Office

volunteers do a lot of folding, stuffing, writing, packaging etc. Graders will actually grade inmate lessons with an answer key. If you feel the desire to serve the Lord in this way, call us for an orientation.

As usual, I hate to see good friends and spiritual partners leave us. But God has always been faithful to supply our needs. I simply marvel at the caliber of men and women who have graced our doors to serve. And we now have two good men in prison, Willie Hubbell and Phil Esposito, who are serving that population with great success. Our discipleship programs are working and families are being blessed.

Oh, on January 22, the postal rates will change. Some metered mail will go down and others will go up. I think our flats, which is the majority of our mail, will be going up 4 cents on the first ounce and it remains to be seen how much on each additional ounce. We will know more in January. Media mail (our books and bibles) will increase by 1.135% also. Because of the proliferation of 'easy reading bibles' we are sending a record number of KJV bibles into prisons and jails. This year to date we have spent \$15,580.00 on postage. But then we are sending enormous amounts of the Word into prisons across America. I think it is a unique investment for us to make in eternity!
