Help for the "Least of These My Brethren"

Brethren, Watching this week as my home state and places very familiar to me are devastated by floods, I am reminded of Katrina and the hurricanes of 2004-2006. In the aftermath of those hurricanes, 4 of which passed over us, volunteers flooded our state to help with the aftermath and clean up. Local churches hosted the rescue teams, housing them in church basements etc. Traveling volunteers like the RV Campers, the Ross's and the Clarks, came to our area to help later that spring. Helping us, they rebuilt the porch on the rear of the ministry.

Once, when working for Operation Rescue in 1991, I witnessed the Body of Christ come from all over the world, literally, in defense of the Unborn babies being killed in third trimester abortion clinics. That corporate move of the Body of Christ amazed me. The power of God to send so many men and women, young and old from across the world, for His purposes still impresses me. I was arrested four times with them in Wichita, Ks., as we protested the abortuaries. I volunteered 6 months with the legal side of helping those arrested. Now I am seeing the same thing as I watched the videos on Samaritanspurse.org. Christians from all over sent by God, bringing themselves to Baton Rouge, La., to help clean up some of the 40,000 homes destroyed in the flooding. They prayed with the victims, they laughed as they worked and they asked nothing in return. These videos broke my heart but made my spirit soar. I graduated Nursing School at the infamously Katrina flooded Charity Hospital in New Orleans. I worked and lived in Baton Rouge in the 1990's. I have relatives there. It means so much to see our donations being used to give not only practical help, but spiritual help as well.

There is so much going on the national stage that the media has pretty much chosen to ignore this disaster. It is said to be hard raising funds without media exposure. **Samaritans Purse has been on the ground from day one, making the impossible possible with the Lord.** I strongly recommend that you go to samatarinspurse.org and watch for yourself. They need more volunteers and more donations. I don't need to tell you that Franklin Graham heads up Samaritans Purse and their charity rating as one of the best, so we are assured that God is in control of it all.

While I am talking about this, I might add that there are many people asking for your money in 'ministry'. I firmly believe right now that the pressing need is for our persecuted brethren in the Middle East. Christians are dying for their faith right now, beheaded, if you will, simply because they name the name of Christ. Search your heart and your conscience to help these precious saints. Give them a cup of water in His name. Even now the dead are under the altar in heaven, pleading "How long O Lord, holy and true, do you not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?" Rev 6:10

narrow minded, "Oh, God wants you to have fun all the time," they say.

My fun is gaining wisdom, knowledge, and understanding which is something I lacked, and that's why I'm here, well, in prison. But since exercising the Wisdom, Knowledge and Understanding the Holy Spirit gave me, I'm using it to better transform my life towards the positive because I desire to be a leader, yes, in the church and my household. So playing cards and anything else that takes me away from my calling, I need to let go. I was mentoring a guy or brother, and he wanted to play cards with me all day. I found myself playing cards, yet lacking in my studies. Immediately I put a stop to it and he got mad. Then when



cheating got involved, I know that's from the devil. And I wanted or tried to keep my mind on those things which are spiritual and not neglect my calling. So, that's why I asked for the information and you blessed me with it. They didn't believe me but now they do! So thanks and may the grace of God continue to bless you. Keep me in your prayers. Because He lives, David L. FL Eileen researched the origin of cards and sent it to him.

Another unusual Post Essay on "your local body" in our bible study. It's very shallow, mostly because we are at a Work Camp. 99% of pastors and clergy think that we don't need ministering to because we are going home soon. But that is so wrong. Most of the men here are between 3, 4, 5, and even 9 years of going home. So most churches and pastors don't come here. This is the biggest problem why inmates come back to prison. They start out serving the Lord, but clergy and pastors neglect Christian men at the Work Camp. Then spiritually they fall because of a lack of fellowship and church. This is one of the reasons I'm doing Bible Studies, a lot of reading and studying. I started out with some bible study, but work outside and other things split this up. Plus, we have brothers who are always arguing Once Saved Always Saved or some kind of divisions.

I helped people in the world before I came in here and never helped anyone in jail or prison. I feel God wants this to be my mission in life.

Essay, Marriage, Family, Parenting Class

I've learned that in life not everything will go your way. And that you have to have an understanding. This class has helped me open my eyes to things I used to be **blind to**. Anywhere from your brain to respecting your spouse to respecting peoples boundaries. I've also learned about family violence and how to prevent it. I've learned that as you were young you don't understand al lot of these things. Now I wish as I was growing up I would have learned what this class has taught me. I might not have put my family or friends what I've been through today. I've also learned about drugs and what they cause to the human brain. I learned more abut God and now it does help to pray and have FAITH. This class opened my eyes to things that will better our livestyles. I also learned a lot of statistics of suicides. I believe that people should take this class on a weekly basis in life. It will help them overcome their addiction. It will also just help a conflict in a marriage or relationship. I know a lot more now than before I took this class. And I'm happy. Thank You!

Essay: Describe your local church in prison, Lesson 3-1

At 10:00 p.m. each night a group of us women do a prayer circle. We pray, lift each other up, give praise reports and every 2 weeks we do charity bags to 2 women who don't have any outside help. Once a week on Sundays starting at 12:00a.m. we do a 24 hour prayer watch. Someone every hour on the hour is praying for 24 hours. We also sing songs to the Lord same as in our prayer circle. If an emergency occurs or someone is downhearted we have emergency prayer call. Amen.

Essay on Discipline, Lesson 4-2

I was abused in my childhood to the point of fear and dread and then finally early teens given up on. Resulting in a terrible effect on my life; resulting in abuse to others and finally ended up in the taking of another human life, of which I'm so so sorry for and only wish a million times over the chance to redo that moment in time that effected so many people over the tragic loss of a person and the taking of his life regardless what triggered the action in a moment's heated argument. Only God made it possible for me to forgive myself, but 'I'm reminded for the past 39 years by the state of Florida, that mercy and forgiveness is not in their laws, which make's receiving and believing God's true mercy and forgiveness even harder, but I can say, His love broke through and is greater than what I'm seeing and feeling so far...forgiving them at this point also was a great break th4rough. Only wish I could be paroled and share the power of God's loving mercy to forgive and save such a true sinner as my past life and be offered and given an eternal heritage in His great kingdom. As an Hispanic man I cannot handle the English language very well. Thanks be to God who through the help of the Holy Spirit I have learned to read and write a little. There are no opportunities for an immigrant to attend school. But thanks be to our Lord, when there a door is shut, He then opens another. As an uneducated man, I can say that by the grace of God I have learned a lot of things here. The most important thing I have learned is about God's word. Now through His word I'm learning how to be a humble servant of the Most High. I'm learning how I can be empowered by the Holy Spirit so that I can serve God first then His dear and chosen people.

Several days ago when I read the testimony of the Founder of this ministry, one of the prison of Miami was mentioned there. the bible or with the Lord. This is a great thing!!! Please pray for them and for our Chaplain and new warden who will be sent to us. One great thing, we have a witness every week. The guard who is usually in the chapel during our classes, is a former student of mine!!
