In Kentucky I did 5 years for methamphetamine. I am terrified of my freedom. I have been locked up so many times that it really feels like I'm coming home. It is also strangely comforting because above all else I know that I am not making any new mistakes today. I am 38 years old and I have done nothing but take from God's world. I would like to enrich it.

But I am constantly plagued with thoughts of the devil's playground that I have chosen to be a part of my entire life. Sometimes I feel like the only way for me to be the decent, caring, sober person I know down deep that I am is to remain locked up forever. Although I used to fight MMA (like wrestling) and am fairly trained in Jiu Jitsu, I am not a violent man. I have never physically hurt anyone who did not attack me first. All of my convictions are the direct result of the use of drugs and alcohol and by the grace of God I have never physically hurt anyone during those bouts either. However, the hearts I've broken of the people who love and have tried to depend on me are countless. I'm a manipulator, a liar, an idolater, an alcoholic, a junkie, a crack head, a thief, and a poor excuse for a father. I have prayed many times for a spiritual experience/ awakening, a personality change sufficient to bring about recovery. I have begged for the change God gave Paul. I guess what I'm saying is I have been searching for direction. The devil dogs my steps. Sometimes I catch myself making plans as to the laws I'll break and the run I'll make should I fail and violate the felony probation I will be once released from here. I'm scared of failure as will as success. I read your prison ministry story and it very much mirrors my own life. I want to change, to live for the Lord, to take care of my family and especially help other people who feel as I do. I could ramble on for days abut my aspirations as well as temptations but I feel you probably understand. I'm not even sure



why I'm writing this. I'm looking for direction. If you could spare any sort of bible study or some advice on connecting with Jesus and changing a sinful heart and mind, I would be forever grateful. Thank you for all you do and for your time. Justin, Mi

Dear Little Lambs,

I request a KJV bible to do the lessons. My name is Linda M. I have a 38 year aggravated sentence. I have done a 15 year flat this year, Jan. 13, 2017. I don't see parole until 2021, for the first time. My charge is sexual assault. It is hard for me because I have this charge because of my second husband. He raped my girls and first me, and I got charged as part of it. I do have a relationship with my children. It is on their time and I do get to see them when they need to see their mom. I need inner peace for this charge & prayer for them each. And pray they find their Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I took my responsibility for them on that situation, they forgave me and want that relationship. I understand they were hurt and taken their innocence away and they had to go it alone after I was taken to prison. I give it to Jesus Christ because without Him in my life, I couldn't have made it in here. I had only 20% of my heart working in 2009. I needed a pacemaker the first year. And a heart donor after that year. By the grace of God and healing, I'm up to 45% of my heart working no pacemaker or heart donor. Jesus Christ. I cried out for healing and to heal my children in their lives. I know with all my heart and soul He is a healing God. I trust and believe in Him, baptized in 2011 & made my Karios Walk first time in 2005. I need to learn more of His Word but I need a KJV bible. Thank you and God bless you. Linda, Tx.

Dear Pastor Salas, I just wanted to write and express how much the little note wrote on my returned lesson means to me. The note mentions you will pray about my parole hearing outcome. Yes, Thank you Hallelujah! I am a man who believes in God's supernatural ability to give good gifts to those who ask in faith without doubt. Of course, if it's His will.

Doubt is not easy to overcome, so when a fellow Christian co-signs the prayer it sharpens the faith. Moreover, the Bible says if any two agree on earth it will be answered. This promise I can testify does work especially if one has the anointing. At San Quentin, one of the brothers has unction so whenever we did an agreement prayer God answered. I wanted to finish a college class, but was told I was on a transfer bus the next day. That night we agreed and prayed. The next morning the bus came and they didn't call me. Later that afternoon the Jewish atheist who ran the college program came and told me, "I don't know why but I felt compelled to go ask the Warden if you could stay to finish the program and he agreed."

I was stunned at this awesome favor from God because others in the college program were on that bus! Also because I would have expected God to work through a Christian or even the Prison Chaplain. God is good!

Later I messed that up with a prison disciplinary and was transferred anyway. I needed still to surrender all my will in that Romans 13 submission to all the Rules which are from God. The Lord Jesus speaks to my heart to tithe to your ministry. Right now I only have a small pay number. I also have not worked as my Boss retired and I have to wait for the new hire. Nevertheless, as I can and in the future more. The blessings are good as the Lord is good. Amen Emil
