July 4th Independence Day . . .or Dependence Day?!

If My people who are called by My name humble themselves and pray, and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from Heaven, will forgive their sin, and will heal their land (2 Chronicles 7:14).

Thank God, Patriotism has come back in style, sort of. God put a love for Israel in the people's hearts, and in sort of the same way, we love our own land. We are perhaps the most blessed nation on earth and it's a privilege to live here in America. But with that privilege comes responsibility. Our military have had that great responsibility throughout our history and valiantly protected her and others. Men and women have suffered and died, first to obtain her freedom and then to keep her free. She has suffered to help the world stay free. Many people believe some of these things but not all. They believe what the culture or their school or media tells them. Your worldview is sort of shaped by the age of 13, refined in school, and passed on as parents. If only 9% of American adults have a biblical worldview, what are they passing on to their children, children who will be our leaders soon in the future. Without a rock solid biblical worldview when they leave your home, they can have their faith stolen by unbelievers in authority over them. Perhaps this is why we have gay marriage, abortion on demand, and infanticide and euthanasia in our own country.

Just as our troops fight to keep us free, we must take responsibility to talk about, to teach, to live our own biblical worldview to a dying, sin-sick world, especially to our children.

This is also a day in which our very Constitution is being challenged by the (Satanic) non-biblical worldview. We pray that each one of you who reads this letter will reaffirm your own dedication to the Lord and to His Word and champion your Independence from man and Dependence on God until the end. Dear Mr. and Mrs. Sala and Little Lambs,

I just wanted to write a thank you letter for the beautiful Study Bible you sent me upon graduation. It was funny, the day it came, they take all wrappings away and at mail call, they called my name and handed the Bible. Everyone laughed as I said, "I wonder where this came from?" Thankfully, the invoice was stuck inside and I saw it came from you. Now for the rest of the story, as Paul Harvey would say!

I was sitting on my bunk, thumbing through it and a man came over, a Hispanic man. We had spoken some and he visited me in my cell (6 of us!)(3 Hispanics). He pointed to the Bible and I handed it to him. He said, "Do you believe that?" I said, "Yes, every word of it!" He said, "I don't. It's a bunch of stories. I also don't believe there is a God or that God created all this. I'm an atheist." I said, "Ok." He said, "I grew up in the Catholic church. I've tried all those 'man-made' religions, like Jehovah's Witness. Ain't none of the worth anything. They are all phony"

I said, "Ok, would you allow me to prove to you that God exists and that He is the Creator. And prove to you this Bible is true and you can depend on what it says?" He said, "I'd love for you to!" So, we agreed to meet and discuss, with all due respect to each other's beliefs. We only met one time for about an hour, a little more. He's a hard one to reach. He said we'd met more but he's been avoiding me for about a week. I'm going to call him out shortly! So, your Bible led to a chance to witness.

Now, for more! A Black man who only arrived about a month ago is a Christian. He saw me get the Bible- shortly afterward, he came up to me and asked if I'd sell it. I told him no. A little later he came to my room and said, I've sure wanted a Bible like that. Here's an offer for it. He offered a piece of paper that was worded so nicely saying he would give me \$20 or 2 flat books of stamps! He just smiled and walked away.



He and I had been talking a lot about the Bible. He would come up to me and me to him trying to stump each other with a question. It was a good natured exchange.

Then the Holy Spirit spoke to my heart. Tears come as I write this! The Spirit said, "You have 5 Bibles!" As I thought about that, this one made 6! I really really liked it and knew there were some great notes, studies, etc. the other Bibles don't have. I told myself, "I can get some very good use out of this new Bible!" The Holy Spirit said, "You have 5 Bibles!" So, I spoke to my Christian cellie and told him the situation. He opened a book he was reading and quoted, "the accumulation of things is one of the worst things we can do. Put things to use or rid yourself of them."

I said, "Ok, I know what I must do!" I walked over to the man wanting to buy the Bible and called him outside his cell. "I will not sell you the Bible. I'll give it to you." I told him I had sent Bibles that I had earned previously to my 2 sons and the boy I call my 3rd son. So, they don't need it. He said, "I'll be your black son!" He hugged my neck with such joy that tears came to us both! Every time I walk by his room, he's in that Bible! He asked for your address and I think he's ordering your study. His last name is McCall.

God bless you wonderful people. You made a wonderful gift touch more than you could think! The greatest blessing was mine, to be able to give the Bible to someone who really needed it. (He had an old ragged Bible from the chapel!) But, the greatest glory goes to God! All honor and praise to Him! Blessings to you and your ministry as I know God will bless it as you do such a valuable work! Graduate

Dear Partners,

This month we highlighted some of our recent graduates. I can't tell you the excitement we feel when we receive letters like this. It's like a major payday from the Lord. We are encouraged to continue although at time we feel somewhat insignificant. But that is as the Lord requires, that we should do our good deeds in secret to be rewarded later. These men and women graduates have worked usually a year and a half or more (one worked 6 years), to complete our program. As a reward we give them a beautiful Study Bible. For most, this is the height of their walk thus far; some are mature and already have good bibles. On page 3, you read the story of one such bible and how it found it's home in a poor man's house. It became a method and a tool to witness and to bless another and to bring them closer to God. I can't count the ways these bibles have influenced thousands of men and women through the years.

But let me tell you how we have managed all these years to award these beautiful \$70 leather and simulated leather Study Bibles. Years ago we were introduced to a beautiful servant of God at a major publishing firm. He has helped us provide these wonderful Study Bibles at a steep discount. He went out of his way to order and ship us these bibles every month or so. He has truly blessed hundreds, no, thousands of men and women and given them a wonderful sword for the battle for righteousness in a dark place. Our wonderful friend is retiring this July after many years of hard work. Although we have stockpiled about 72 bibles, we have no plan in place for acquiring Study Bibles after he retires other than to order each bible individually, but we are praying and asking God to make up the void. If any of you have contacts with publishers or the like please intervene for us! Otherwise pray for the next step!



In June, Mary Tinberg and myself have begun a Monday class and meeting at the Highlands County Jail with the women in B-Block as a replacement for Ms. Bobbi Graham while she is on sabbatical. Mrs. Shirley Johnson, Volunteer Supervisor at the HCJ, has been a great help in implementing new classes and lessons at the jail. We look forward to many new things from her. Please pray for these 19 women we are meeting with. They need direction, wisdom, and strength desperately.

The hot doldrums of summer are here. Today, as I write this, is a cool heat index of 101 degrees! Just as the people have vanished to live in cooler climes, so has our funding. As a rule we do not ask for money. Our covenant with the Lord is, when He no longer funds us, we will simply close the doors. But we do want to let you know that although our expenses exceed our income in summer, we continue to cut corners and provide the same service to all the incarcerated. We turn down all free people and refer them to local churches and save all our funds for our mission, the incarcerated. Our great team of volunteers work just as hard and help to limit our costs. Thank you for your continued support for the prisoners. You enable us to love them in extraordinary ways.
