others Day! Why did God create us so that it is necessary to have two people, a male and a female, to produce a baby? And humans make babies without an expensive laboratory and equipment or a controlled environment. God's plan is 'and two become one."!Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh. KJV Gen 2:24 That new "one flesh" carries both his mom and dad inside himself along with seed to produce more of himself.

Two people- a mom and a dad, a male and a female, loving each other. This provides that 'baby one' with a godly, loving environment so he can grow, be different and have his needs met until he learns to meet his own needs. God knew the physical dangers a young child would face and the emotional challenges in their future so He provided stability by giving the child 2 loving parents.

The God-given roles of Mother and Father are perhaps the most important roles we will ever fulfill. These roles determine the character of the next generation. To have a godly home is in opposition to our culture. It takes brave mothers and fathers to limit the cultures influence on their children. This requires very secure parents in the Lord, and we have only about 18 years to build this foundation.

Some of us have failed, we have let the culture countermand Christ. We have yielded or been silent at strategic points. We now have abortion on demand that says God didn't really mean to create you. He made a mistake. We have gender-reassignment which is really saying, God made another mistake when He gave you your sex! We have given mothers the right to play God when pregnant! A kid soon learns God is not all that powerful! So our kids grow up with a little g god instead of a big G God. They lose all fear of God. *There is no fear of God before their eyes. Rom 3:18* 

Part of God's plan was for a husband and father to love God, their wives and children and model that love before his children. They would grow up knowing what a male, a husband and a father should be and do. The greatest gift a father can give his children is to love their mother! Mothers are to model that same love towards God, her husband and children so that they would not be confused about their role later in life. Children's prefrontal cortex of the brain, the seat of judgments and self control and personality, do not mature until they're 25-26 years old. So confusing gender messages from our culture have a profound effect on a child without life experience and maturity to fully understand the path they are taking or to make sound judgments. Your influence is powerful. The relationship between the father and the mother will set the tone in the home and health of the children.

Mothers and Fathers, be aware of the holy calling from God to give your children a firm biblical foundation and prepare to be profoundly blessed!

Dear All at Little Lambs and Sala Ministry:

Praise the name of our heavenly Father first & foremost. Praise Him!

We, this unit is currently on a major lock-down/shake - down. This place has gone and will continue to get worse. I predicted two or three years ago, at least by 2018 and no later than 2020, this unit would become super violent. Why?

This place is turned into a 'medical' unit. And people on the outside so, "So?" Well, allot of people take meds that alter their ways. Since my major seizure in 2014, they have had me on the wrong meds at first; then, not enough; too much; then stopped which can be deadly, cause a stroke or cause more seizures. I got the latter. I can get really angry for really no reason. Yet, others are pure NUTZO! However, it is clearly apparent the guards are trained to be guards only. They are clueless on how to handle a person with seizures or other major illnesses. The gurney, we call 'the ambulance', the trained medical person walk and talk as if nothing is going on. When they arrive, and the person is dead; they pick up the body.

There have also be a sharp rise in stabbings, being hit in the head with a small fan motor, stuff like that! The illicit drug use is unbelievable. Major fights are now daily.

One dude walked by me 'rapping' with a black eye, cuts on his back (not all on the same day receiving such), but was saying, "You know I'm sorry, I know I'm no good, I'm worthless to others, and I hate my mom, friends, and I know there is no God..."

It's cold. No heaters. The vents are on. I still praise our Lord for He saw me and loved me to die not only for me, but for the world. Amen. HP

Please make this you man and his institution, it's administration, a matter of urgent prayer.

Another urgent prayer request

With this lesson I'd like to add a very important prayer request, if you don't mind. A guy here on our unit was recently killed by another inmate and I'd just like everyone

out there to pray for him, his family and friends, just everyone involved with this situation. We are currently on lockdown status and have been since March 7, 2019 because of this situation. But I continue to do God's work, and what He has planned for me!! Thank ya'll for every lesson and I'm looking forward to my lesson!! Hi, this is Brother James and thought I'd send you a brief letter because I was transferred to another prison. I don't know if you remember me. I recently got myself into some legal trouble and was facing life without parole. While fighting my case for over 2 years in the county jail, I believe there was a transformation over my soul and a facelift where this face went from the lights being out then someone turned on the lights!

I think a lot of people get caught up in wanting to live on earth forever. I believe you can be dead and still be upright and your heart still beating. But there's a difference between living and feeling alive through Christ.

I'll take death in the flesh and all the things material-wise that this world has to offer and trade it in to live for Christ. I know while I was in that county jail and my life was like a boxer in the ring and I was cornered and there was no way out from the punches I was taking from my opponent. And just when I thought the odds against me were going to win and defeat me, the Lord stepped in and said my life was worth saving. I do hope you remember me. Christian friends are hard to come by and I got rid of old acquaintances and bad habits and examples of that life style. My friendship network is small and if I can be honest with you, it gets real lonely doing this righteous walk and dropping old past friends. Write soon, Your Christian friend, J

April was a whirlwind. And I mean whirlwind. My ceiling leaked and water dripped from every part of the ceiling in my laundry. Faulty new roof!! The challenges keep coming, but we are victors over all.

As graduation nears for our local GCBI school as well as our Hogar Resa, we will miss the students. Although here under different circumstances, both will greatly impact young peoples lives. Jan will miss her sponsored student, and I will miss Keith, Director of the Sebring Hogar. Keith has helped us with so many things at the ministry and at home this year. He is obtaining his CDL license and plans to travel as work. Also graduating will be the Hogar Resa State Supervisor and Sebring Hogar resident, Aldo Guzman. He became a dear friend and always a joy and a help. We have often basked in the gratitude shown by these men. Aldo married during his last segment of the program and continues to work with courts throughout southern Florida. He keeps the 6 Hogars at capacity. I recently toured the lastest home on Gloria St in Avon Park. It has been gutted and beautifully done and is welcoming place for senior staff of the program. The men are so proud of their work. Feel free to visit any Hogar and ask for a tour or call Aldo for a tour. They love to show off their handiwork and blessings.

We also completed a three day seminar on Anger Management with a total of 11 people attending and graduating. All have now met their court ordered demands or Parenting Classes. "Woke" is a new cultural term added to Merriam-Webster, that means a new self-awareness, striving for something better, roused from an inactive state. This term reminded me of the attitudes of the class. I pray that these men and women stay "woke", awaken to a new self-awareness and the effects of their behaviors on those around them, and action to change. It was great to see several of the guys requesting to photo the illustration on the board of the dysfunctional family to show their wives at home. A sudden awareness of dysfunction rampant in the home! We pray that they will seek God as never before for wholeness!



Left, first man standing, is our own Monte Dowling, featured in the local newspaper. Monte is a Monday volunteer and printer and has served God with Little Lambs for almost 10 years now. A Navy veteran from Lake Placid, Monte also volunteers with Hospice at The Manor in Sebring, a dementia unit. The military veterans held a 'Salute" for the six vet residents at the home. Monte also trained and became an auxiliary state trooper while working with us. He is often called to work big accidents, fog, or ball games, even Daytona races. It seems that be-

tween all his volunteer activities and visiting his large family, he has no time to be idle. We tease him that you almost have to make an appointment to see him he's so busy! We do appreciate all his help through the years as he has worked alongside his father-in-law and his wife, both now deceased, for Little Lambs.

As Mother's Day approaches, I think like my friend, Boon. I wish I had known the things I know now when I was raising my children! I am a different person now from then. The greatest difference is that I know God. God has changed me. I had a few years with my children as a Christian but I began unsaved and without the peace of God. Knowing God makes me a better grandmother. Whatever the state, the gift of our children, a loan from God, is our greatest joy and our legacy. I pray that God take all our lives and glorify Himself more and more in every way. Happy Mothers Day to all those who are raising children and raising spiritual children.
