When you reach the end of where you are, that is the beginning of where God is. No matter where you find your self in life you cannot max out God.

|What have you earned in Parenting Class?

I've learned a lot in class. Most of all I've learned how messed up I was. Some things I heard mimicked my life and my relationships. I knew I needed a change in my behavior. I also needed to repent my sins. So I have been praying. I have reached out to my loved ones that I was verbally abusive to and asked them for forgiveness after I told them how sorry I was for the pain I caused them. If it wasn't for this

class I wouldn't even know the harm I caused.

I learned about dysfunctional families. How dysfunctional my family was because of me the addict. My wife was my codependent and I controlled her in every way besides physically. My children suffered from my behavior. Now that I look back, I can see how they did take different rolls to please me or my wife.

I've learned to be functional, I need to keep God in my life. Stay on top of my readings. He will keep me righteous. My family will see the difference in my behavior from all I've learned in this class. God will keep me on the right path in my recovery.

I know now from class that I can't just go out and find any woman. My relationship with my wife was doomed to fail because we were both messed up with empty love tanks. I can't just fall head over heels for just any woman. I know I need a woman with good morals and a woman with a good relationship with God.

I also had hidden anger. From the teachings I realized where this anger stems and how to learn from that so there won't be a cycle. I figure this is where all my verbal abuse came from. I learned this behavior is hurtful and feel it can brainwash my loved ones. So now I know where my hidden anger comes from and what not to do.

Lastly I learned how to detach from people. How to talk reason with them and if that fails I say "NO", walk away from that bad relationship. If I believe it will only bring harm to both of us then the relationship was not worth the heartache. It can be hard but we all need to love the right people and life will be good.

I cannot blame my parents for my actions. I had no empty tank growing up. I lived in only 2 homes since age of 5. My parents were good providers and very loving to me and each other. They had no addiction and never hurt each other in anyway. My parents did not use drugs and only drank on special occasions. My dad worked for the same company for 47 years. My mom is a housewife and only worked to provide us a better Christmas and to have her dream pool. The fault lays in my own self -esteem problem and over-active Limbic part of my brain. I chose to use alcohol and drugs to mask my own faults and because of my alcohol and drug use I drained my own tank and everyone around me. So I have no one but myself to blame for my addictions and problems in my life. This class has enlightened me as to my own faults and has changed how I look at life. I wish I could go back and change the course I took. I ruined what would have been a truly wonderful and loving life. The alcohol made me a monster and the drugs helped me cope. Never again.

Now I'd like to thank Mrs. Sala for teaching us about Boundaries...one of the most important characteristics to me, that's been identified by our teacher. Why? Because boundaries sets the true tone for any relationship between two or more living beings. How so? It establishes limitations for both parties. For example: if you come to a friend's house and there's a closed gate, with a No Trespassing sign and a Beware of Dog sign, with a lock secured on the latch. They've established clearly that no one should enter unless they unlock the gate, put away the dog, and welcome them in. (Removing the boundaries!) You're not permitted to shoot the dog, jump the gate, or cut the lock. This would be a clear violation of your friends' boundaries. Boundaries in marriage says: you can not say or do whatever you want when you decide to. It says to think about her feelings and emotional state before acting, even if you are the man. (The human species has the greatest problem with boundaries of others, especially with our significant others.) Boundaries say: You can't disrespect physically or verbally; accept no, no cheating; no demeaning; no running from; but talk rationally, reasoning through problems productively, respond instead of react, saying no to express your boundaries; no mind-altering drugs because unsober minds make irrational decisions due to intoxication. Not exercising the boundaries of remaining sober causes us to hurt. I know that it's not going to be easy reversing what's already been done, but I'm trusting God to be my strength, power and might where the changing of my family is concerned.

I wanted to add a little note to my lesson to share with you how much you both mean to me. You're little notes, pamphlets, and comments have shown genuine care and concern to me, someone you don't know. It is this kind of hope and love that solidifies Christ's love in this world I am in such an evil place that it's often hard to remember that. It's extremely difficult to follow God where I'm at, but it's at times like that I remember Daniel, Mordecai, Shadrach, Meshak and Abednego, Paul, Job and Jonah. God never promised an "easy life" through Christianity. There is so much homosexuality, drugs and violence around me. I spend ALL my time in my studies. I am in a lock-down unit so I do not get to enjoy fellowship except with those in my unit, and there are very few believers. I do not get Chapel privileges either. Almost every one in my family is dead so I really struggling with depression and loneliness. My wife passed away at 29 in February and I miss my children so badly that it is often hard to breathe. I have been locked up now for 7 years, 4 1/2 left to go. I want you to know that the bible studies change my life daily. I love you and thank you for all your do for all of us in the name of Christ Jesus. I am in my permanent camp and look forward to my next lesson. Please send it post-haste! TS, Fl

Dear Partners,

Because Thanksgiving is at the end of the month, we are given a whole month to devote to specially thanking God for all our many blessings. We are blessed that our snowbirds are coming home. We are especially blessed to see the men of the Hogar Resa drug program seeking God and able to attend church with us. You might not remember but it was 5 years ago in April, 2014, that they began occupying the Grace Place Home on Magnolia. Designed for women, it has housed up to 17 men at a time for drug treatment. It is indeed a special place that you all have helped us build and maintain as a gift to Hogar and the men. A few years ago, the Hogar opened that home for women in Avon Park that we had hoped to have. The Women's program continues today. At our home, the Hogar President Carmelo Ruiz, has begun a renovation including painting inside and outside, repair and painting of all the fencing and the porch. They are installing new televisions, one on the porch, for the residents; refreshing all the beds and bedding and some fixtures. Even the garden has undergone renovation with new walkways, landscaping and an area for lifting weights. Having now 5 homes for residents, they have a dedicated crew for maintenance who are quite good and quick. Presently they will be getting ready for the holidays!

November will mark another Anger Management session. This will include a Parenting Class certificate as well. We will do the course over the second week of November for 12 hours of class. This class is also excellent if your are in a troubled marriage. Registration is by appointment and all are welcome.

Old friends of mine have moved to our area, Richard and Roberta Dunn. I mentored them years ago at Christian Retreat. Founding a Teen Challenge in Arcadia, Fl., years ago, they have now semi-retired and Richard works as a contractor. Richard and Roberta are two of the few people who have taken my advice and watched "Fat, Sick and Nearly Dead" movie and changed their life totally, being healed of so many maladies and losing tons of weight. After 11 stents, Richard is now enjoying good heart health and maybe only one medication. Because of such a tremendous recovery for Roberta, she has decided to devote her life now to helping others gain health like she has. After studying extensively, she has begun a service in Sebring to provide absolutely gluten free meals according to the Dr. Gundry plan. She is an excellent cook and improvised a number of great recipes. No longer eating in restaurants, they have their own hens and pastured eggs, are growing a garden and will soon be raising pastured chickens, make their own sausage using pastured beef. As we count our blessings, we rejoice that God has fulfilled the scripture for us in Isaiah 54:2-3: Enlarge the place of your tent and let them stretch forth the curtains of your habitations; Spare not, lengthen your cords, and strengthen your stakes; for you shall break forth on the right hand and on the left.
