## God's Sanitation Precepts...Waging War

We have a biblical example of what is happening today. In Exodus, when the plagues came upon the Egyptians, the Israelites were safe in their land of Goshen. In all the plagues, notice that they were always "in the land of Egypt, in your houses," not in the homes of the Israelites. In Exodus 8:22, God tells Pharaoh that God has divided the land of Goshen from Egypt as he brought the plague of flies upon Egypt. For the remainder of plagues, the land of the Israelites were saved from them. On the last plague of the death angel, the Israelites were commanded to sacrifice the first Passover Lamb and put the blood of the lamb over their doorposts. When the death angel saw the blood, he passed over that house and no one died. This was the first "isolation technique" or quarantine or social distancing and taught by the Lord!

Then the Lord gave the Israelites the 'sanitary laws' of the bible. Leviticus 12-15 gives us these laws mainly separation/isolation of the unclean or unclean things. All the war spoils of the Canaanites were to be burned, probably because they were a very unclean society. Things were purified by fire, water or the blood.

Today a raging epidemic (noisome pestilence) stalks our land. Psalm 91 is our defense in this crisis and truly every day. Just as faith in the blood was the key to salvation at Passover, so it is today. In the spirit we proclaim Jesus over our households, we plead His blood over our homes and families. We proclaim the word of God as we trust Him to honor His Word.

Remember, when on 9/11/02 God removed the hedge of protection over our nation, causing great devastation and a fleeting moment of repentance? Indeed it was fleeting as very soon people returned to business as usual and defiance toward God. Perhaps this is another warning. The hedge of protection has been removed for 'nominally Christian' nations across the world with the corona virus. It is not business as usual. I believe God is thundering from heaven a warning. Who is listening?

Jesus was asked in Mathew 24:3 "Tell us, when shall these things be and what shall be he sign of your coming, and the end of the world?" He answered in verse 6, "and you shall hear of wars and rumors of wars; see that you be not troubled for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom ( as it is today), and there shall be famine (Africa today is threat-ened by hordes of locusts bringing famine), and pestilence (corona virus), and earthquakes (Utah this week had another quake and in other places) in different places. All these are the beginning of sorrows."

My message is—Look Up– your redemption draws high. Be aware of the signs of the times, the times in which we live. One of the precepts of Holy War is to choose men or women to war with you who understand the times in which they live and know a Christian what to do (1 Chr 12:30). Another law is to choose men to war with you who are not of a double heart (cowards) as 1 Chr 12:33 states, "who could keep rank: they were not of **double heart**," Another precept of holy war is to choose men or women who "we experts in war, with all manner of instruments of war for the battle (instruments of our warfare are spiritual: holiness, praise, worship, prayer, service, obedience.)

Another precept of war, sanctify the camp (holiness), touch not the unclean thing and I will walk in you to deliver you from your enemies. Deuteronomy gives us a clear and present example of what the Lord was talking about in this precept, rather graphically illustrating it for us...

<sup>9</sup> When the host goes forth against your enemies, then keep you from every wicked thing. You shall have a place also without the camp, whither thou shall go forth abroad (to relieve yourself): <sup>13</sup>And you shall have a paddle (a wide end) upon your weapon; and it shall be, when you will ease thyself abroad, you shall dig therewith, and shall turn back and cover that which comes from you:

The next verse is the spiritual application of holiness in warfare: For the LORD your God walks in the midst of your camp (your life, your home, family), to deliver you, and to give up your enemies before you; therefore shall your camp be holy: that he see <u>no unclean thing</u> in you, and <u>turn away from you</u>. Deu 23:9; 12-14

Beloved, lets sanctify our camps! Purge out sin (leaven), unbelief, uncleanness. Believe, obey, pray, plead the blood of Jesus over your families, friends, our lambs, our volunteers, our leaders, and this nation. Pray for a more real, deep biblical repentance that changes lives. Pray that our mortality will cause many to truly repent and believe Jesus.

Beloved, my prayers are for you all. Little Lambs is closed for now as we navigate this crisis and pray. We will resume as soon as the danger to our volunteers is past. We will get our mail every day and I will work that mail for now until restrictions are removed on isolation. Being a nurse, I realize that our first line of defense is just what God said, "Separation", or isolation. Please add your prayers for those who continue working throughout the crisis and are in danger of infection at any time, service personal as well as medical personal. They are our front line troops.

We love you and pray fervently for you. Please stay safe under the blood of Jesus.
