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Dear Little Lambs,

Certainly the Christmas story as told in Chapter 2 of Luke's Gospel will always be among our most cherished Scriptures. The journey of Mary and Joseph to Bethlehem. The manger scene and the swaddling clothes. And even the frightened shepherds abiding in the field. But what about the *prophecies* surrounding the birth of the Christ child. For our Christmas devotion this year, we have chosen an often overlooked, but tender and moving moment—the saintly old prophet, Simeon, as he takes the baby Jesus into his arms, as recorded in Luke 2:25-35. Our story takes place on the eighth day, as Mary and Joseph present their newborn child in the temple to be circumcised in accordance with the law of Moses. Of course, on this side of Calvary, we understand that Jesus came in part, to set us free from much of the ceremonial law. But at that time, to ignore this ancient rite would have been an unnecessary stumbling block for the very ones He came to save. Simeon was there, not by chance or coincidence, but by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. Although we do not know very much about Simeon, perhaps the privilege accorded him here tells us all we need to know—Simeon was given the honor of pronouncing THE BLESSING on the Lord Jesus. Certainly, Simeon was a good man, just and devout. But more than that, he had been "waiting for the consolation of Israel" —the coming of the Messiah-for a very long time. Luke 2:25 (KJV).

No doubt Simeon knew the many Old Testament prophecies concerning the Messiah. Long before, he would have memorized "Behold a virgin shall conceive and bear a son and shall call His name Immanuel" and "For unto us a child is born unto us a son is given . . ." Isaiah 7:14; 9:6. But beyond our comprehension, Simeon had watched and waited, studied and searched, hoped and prayed. For a lifetime! And so when the Holy Spirit woke him up on that eighth day and whispered "Today is the day. The Messiah is come" we cannot begin to imagine the unspeakable joy and celebration of his heart.

Of course, the child was to <u>be called</u> **JESUS** in keeping with the annunciation of the angel Gabriel. And like new parents since the beginning of time, Mary beamed and Joseph's chest swelled with pride. But could these proud-as-a-peacock parents really understand or appreciate the <u>magnitude</u> of this day? Probably not.

But Simeon knew. Or should we say that the Holy Spirit speaking thru Simeon, knew. Previously, the Holy Spirit had revealed to Simeon that he would not die until he had seen the Lord. Not surprisingly, God did better than His promise, as Simeon took the baby Jesus *into his arms* with the greatest affection imaginable. And at that moment, prophecy itself was resurrected after a silence of almost four hundred years, as Simeon boldly declared "Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace . . .For mine eyes have seen thy salvation" Luke 2:29-30. Having welcomed and blessed the Messiah, Simeon could look his own death in the eye, in peace.

But the Holy Spirit had one more message to deliver. Speaking directly to Mary, Simeon concluded "Yea a sword shall pierce through thy own soul . . ." Luke 2:35. An ominous warning? Perhaps, but for what??! Maybe in the joy and celebration of this special day, Mary's attention would have been diverted away from such a dark and disturbing thought of a sword piercing her soul. In fact, maybe she didn't even give that warning another thought—until she stood at the foot of the cross . . .

So on this Christmas Day, receive the Gospel with faith, and you too shall welcome the Lord Jesus Christ into your arms.


